Indiana Mare Registrations Due June 1, 2009

Beginning with the 2009 breeding season, there are now (3) three classifications of horses which are eligible to participate in the Indiana Breed Development Program. They are as follows:

Indiana Sired & Bred Defined: A foal sired by a registered Indiana stallion and from a mare which resides in the State of Indiana continuously from June 1st of the breeding year through time of foaling and (30) thirty days after and is properly registered with the Indiana Horse Racing Commission. **(Mare must be registered)**

Indiana Sired (only): A foal sired by a registered Indiana stallion and from a mare which does not reside in the State of Indiana and is not registered with the Indiana Horse Racing Commission. **(Mare does not have to be registered)**

Indiana Bred Defined: A foal from a mare which resides in the State of Indiana continuously from June 1st of the breeding year through time of foaling and (30) thirty days after and is properly registered with the Indiana Horse Racing Commission. **(Mare must be registered)**

In order for foals of 2010 to be considered either Indiana Sired & Bred (ISB) or Indiana Bred (IB), mares must be registered with the Indiana Horse Racing Commission and residing in the State of Indiana on or before **June 1, 2009**.

Please Note: Only mares that are going to reside in the State of Indiana and participate in the *Indiana Sired & Bred* or *Indiana Bred* portion of the program need to be registered with the Indiana Horse Racing Commission.
