Essay Contest Winners Receive:

First Place: The first place winner will have their essay published in the Indianapolis Recorder and receive an Indianapolis Clowns throwback jersey as worn by the Indians during the Third Annual Civil Rights Game on August 22, 2014. They will also receive 8 tickets to the game on Friday, August 22, 2014 and have the opportunity to throw out the ceremonial first pitch with Indiana Civil Rights Commission's Executive Director, Jamal Smith.

Second Place: The second place winner will receive an Indianapolis Indians T-shirt and four tickets to the Third Annual Civil Rights Game on Friday, August 22, 2014 at Victory Field.
