Think before pouring anything down the sink!



Keep all liquid and solid medications and household chemicals out of the trash and the water supply.

Do not dispose of unwanted medicines by pouring them down the drain or flushing them down a toilet. Many medications cannot be removed by wastewater treatment plants.

Some household products containing hazardous substances become household hazardous waste (HHW) once the consumer no longer has a use for them.
