

**CCDF FACT SHEET  
INDIANA - STATEWIDE SUMMARY  
VOUCHER AND CONTRACT CENTERS PROGRAMS  
February, 2013**

**Caseload**

19,787 families and 37,441 children were authorized for this period.  
293 of the above families and 380 of the children had vouchers with CCDF Contract Centers.  
2,367 families and 3,723 children were on wait lists at the end of the period.

**Children**

75% of children were served in licensed care.  
1.9% of children were cared for by relatives.  
School-age children (ages 6+ years) constitute 34.4% of all children served.  
3.8% of children had part-time vouchers.  
Children of Hispanic or Latino Ethnicity accounted for 9.7% of all children served.  
Race codes: African American: 59.5%; White: 48%; American Indian / Alaskan: 0.6%; Asian: 0.4%; Hawaiian / Pacific Islander: 0.2%  
There were 380 new TANF-Impact children (225 families) added this period.

**Families**

90.3% of families received subsidies because of employment.  
24.1% of families had copayments, at an average of 7% of income.  
The average family size was 3.8 and the average number of children served per family was 1.9.  
95.5% of families were headed by a single parent.  
11.6% of families were marked as TANF recipients and 10.6% listed TANF as a source of income.  
75.9% of families were below the poverty level. 6.6% of families were above 127% of poverty.

**Expenditures**

The average cost of care for a month per child during this period was \$377 (monthly subsidy + parent fee).  
Parents paid 4.9% of the cost and the program paid 95.1%.  
Average monthly expenditures for children under 1 year of age were \$419.  
Average monthly expenditures for school-age children (ages 6+ years) were \$282.  
71.8% of total expenditures were for children under 6 years of age.  
Fiscal Year to Date Expenditures through end of period\*: \$68,314,070  
Total payments made in period\*: \$12,624,949  
70% of allocated funds were obligated as of the last budget cycle during the period.  
87.8% of obligated funds were expended for most recent four weeks of paid service periods.

**Providers**

Authorized CCDF providers by type\*\*: Licensed Centers: 453; Licensed Homes: 2,595; Registered Ministries: 458; Exempt Centers: 290; Exempt Homes: 411.  
Percent of providers participating in CCDF\*\*: Licensed Centers: 76.3%; Licensed Homes: 92%; Registered Ministries: 67.2%.

**County Stats**

Marion County accounted for the largest proportion of families served with 30.7% of the caseloads.  
The highest average cost of care was in Hamilton County at \$590 per child. The lowest average cost of care was in Cass County at \$194 per child.  
Union County and others had the greatest proportion of children served in licensed care at 100%.  
Jay County ranks first in relative care statewide with 10.3% of all children cared for by relatives.  
Blackford County and others had the highest percentage of families with service need of employment at 100%.  
Union County had the greatest proportion of TANF recipients, where 25.% of families receiving child care subsidies also received TANF income.
