Indiana Department of Correction Executive Summary

The following document provides a statistical review of the Indiana Department of Correction offender population during the month of March 2007. Numerous tables and graphs in this report have been updated from previous report formats in order to present a more representative and consistent picture of the IDOC population.

- An additional category has been added to Table 1 that acknowledges the number of Other Vacancies at each facility. These vacancies have historically not been reported. Other Vacancies include segregation, infirmary, down, or held beds.
- An additional category has been added to Table 2 that allows for a comparison of the previous month's operational capacity to the current report month's operational capacity.
- The 'Misdemeanant' and 'Unsentenced' categories previously in Table 5 have been removed. The IDOC does not house misdemeanor offenders and any 'Unsentenced' offenders are now accounted for in the 'Felon' category.
- The title of Table 6 has been changed to reflect the variety of reasons why jail beds are contracted. Consequently, the titles of Female Graph C and Male Graph F also reflect this change.
- The Average Daily Community Transition Program Population, now Table 7, is now presented in a more accurate and comprehensive trend analysis format. Due to the fact that seasonal trending is normal for the CTP program, it is more appropriate to report program population by comparison month for each year. Table 7 now reflects the program population by month for each year from 2002 to present and demonstrates a consistent upward trend in program enrollment.

The changes made to the specific areas of the Offender Population Statistical Report for the month of March 2007 will continue to be included on all future reports. The changes made will help to ensure the accuracy of the reported data, as well as consistency throughout the report.

Indiana Department of Correction Population Summary

- There were 23,431 adult male offenders (including 979 county jail “back-ups” and 100 in contracted beds) on March 31, 2007.
This population is 1% above the operational bed capacity.

- There were 2,129 adult female offenders (including 57 county jail “back-ups” and 37 in contracted beds) on March 31, 2007.
This population is 4% below the operational bed capacity.

- There were 879 juvenile male offenders in the Department’s facilities on March 31, 2007. This population is 25% below the operational bed capacity.

- There were 171 juvenile female offenders in the Department’s facilities on March 31, 2007. This population is 45% below the operational bed capacity.

- There were 7,666 adult males on parole in Indiana (6,992 Indiana parolees and 674 other jurisdiction parolees) on March 31, 2007.

- There were 874 adult females on parole in Indiana (769 Indiana parolees and 105 other jurisdiction parolees) on March 31, 2007.

- There were 479 juvenile males on parole in Indiana (434 Indiana parolees and 45 other jurisdiction parolees) on March 31, 2007.

- There were 78 juvenile females on parole in Indiana (72 Indiana parolees and 6 other jurisdiction parolees) on March 31, 2007.

Definitions

For the purpose of this report, the following definitions apply:

Admission – The means by which an offender enters the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of the return of an escapee, this does not include a return from a temporary absence.

Average Daily Population – The sum of the daily beginning counts for a month, divided by that month's number of daily beginning counts.

Beginning Count – The number of offenders physically present at the beginning of the day (ie, 0000:01 hours).

Class A Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of thirty years, with not more than twenty years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Class B Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of ten years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than four years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Class C Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of four years, with not more than four years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than two years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Class D Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of one and one-half years, with not more than one and one-half years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than one year subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

County Jail "Back-ups" (Jail Bed Count) Those offenders who have been committed to the Indiana Department of Correction, but are housed in a county jail until they can be transferred to a Department of Correction intake facility. The county receives \$35.00 per day, per offender, to house these offenders.

Ending Count – The number of offenders physically present at the end of the day (ie, 2400:00 hours).

Felon – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for more than one year.

Level 1 Security Classification – Minimum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 1 have the least restrictive security measures in place.

Level 2 Security Classification – Medium security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 2 have a moderate degree of security measures in place.

Level 3 Security Classification – Maximum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 3 have very restrictive security measures in place.

Misdemeanant – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for not more than one year.

Murder – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of fifty-five years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Operational Capacity – The total bed capacity of the facility. The capacity of a facility is the number of beds authorized for safe and efficient operation of the facility.

Pre-Dispositional – An individual ordered by the Court to the Indiana Department of Correction for evaluation prior to sentencing.

Release – The means by which an offender leaves the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of an escape, this does not include a temporary absence.

Safekeeper – An individual whom the Court has determined to be in imminent danger of serious bodily injury or death, or who represents a substantial threat to the safety of others, and whom the Court has ordered to the Indiana Department of Correction for custody and security control.

Secure Confinement Units – Denotes maximum control with the most restrictive security measures in place.

Vacancy – The number of beds available for assignment.




















