Indiana Department of Correction Executive Summary

Table 5

- The total admissions for adult males decreased significantly in April 2007 from the previous month. Adult male admissions in March were 1,423 and decreased 23% in April to 1,091. Adult female admissions also decreased a significant 26% from March to April with 246 admissions in March and 181 admissions in April.
 - Of those admissions the majority of the percent change was noticed in New Commitments, which decreased 23% for males and 41% for females; Parole Violators with New Commitments, which decreased 38% for males from March to April; and Technical Parole Violators, which decreased 29% for males from March to April. However, Probation Violation, New Commitments increased 43% from March to April for males.

- The number of Department adult male offenders held in county jails increased from 979 in March to 1,201 in April, which represents a 22% increase. The increase was distributed fairly evenly across all the counties, however Hamilton County increased over 3.5 times from 13 males in March to 46 males in April and Wayne County increased over 7 times from 7 males in March to 50 males in April. These numbers represent newly sentenced adult offenders with completed paperwork who are awaiting transfer to a IDOC facility. The increase in male offenders could be attributed to a variety of reasons including sentencing trends, Department bed availability, and casework completion processes.

- Class A offenses for adult males decreased 46% from 86 offenses in March to 46 offenses in April. The largest decrease was witnessed in IC 35-48-4-1, Dealing Cocaine or Narcotic Drug, which demonstrated a 35% decrease from March to April.
- Class B offenses for adult males also decreased 31% from March to April, again with the largest single offense decrease occurring in IC 35-48-4-1, Dealing in Cocaine or Narcotic Drug (-28%).
- Class C offenses for adult males decreased 19% from March to April, with decreases spread relatively evenly throughout the specific offense categories.
- Class D offenses for adult females decreased 29% and for males decreased 23%. For both genders the majority of the decrease was seen in IC 35-43-4-2, Theft. Female offenses for theft decreased 42% and male offenses for theft decreased 23% from March to April.

- Juvenile male New Commitments decreased 24% from 94 in March to 71 in April. However, this appears to be a return to the normal number of new juvenile male commitment, with March being the exception to the trend.

Indiana Department of Correction Population Summary

- There were 23,539 adult male offenders (including 1,201 county jail “back-ups” and 98 in contracted beds) on April 30, 2007. This population is 1% above the operational bed capacity.

- There were 2,101 adult female offenders (including 46 county jail “back-ups” and 35 in contracted beds) on April 30, 2007. This population is 6% below the operational bed capacity.

- There were 897 juvenile male offenders in the Department’s facilities on April 30, 2007. This population is 24% below the operational bed capacity.

- There were 181 juvenile female offenders in the Department’s facilities on April 30, 2007. This population is 42% below the operational bed capacity.

- There were 7,821 adult males on parole in Indiana (7,144 Indiana parolees and 677 other jurisdiction parolees) on April 30, 2007.

- There were 923 adult females on parole in Indiana (814 Indiana parolees and 109 other jurisdiction parolees) on April 30, 2007.

- There were 489 juvenile males on parole in Indiana (439 Indiana parolees and 50 other jurisdiction parolees) on April 30, 2007.

- There were 76 juvenile females on parole in Indiana (70 Indiana parolees and 6 other jurisdiction parolees) on April 30, 2007.

Definitions

For the purpose of this report, the following definitions apply:

Admission – The means by which an offender enters the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of the return of an escapee, this does not include a return from a temporary absence.

Average Daily Population – The sum of the daily beginning counts for a month, divided by that month's number of daily beginning counts.

Beginning Count – The number of offenders physically present at the beginning of the day (ie, 0000:01 hours).

Class A Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of thirty years, with not more than twenty years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Class B Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of ten years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than four years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Class C Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of four years, with not more than four years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than two years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Class D Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of one and one-half years, with not more than one and one-half years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than one year subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

County Jail "Back-ups" (Jail Bed Count) – Those offenders who have been committed to the Indiana Department of Correction, but are housed in a county jail until they can be transferred to a Department of Correction intake facility. The county receives \$35.00 per day, per offender, to house these offenders.

Ending Count – The number of offenders physically present at the end of the day (ie, 2400:00 hours).

Felon – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for more than one year.

Level 1 Security Classification – Minimum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 1 have the least restrictive security measures in place.

Level 2 Security Classification – Medium security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 2 have a moderate degree of security measures in place.

Level 3 Security Classification – Maximum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 3 have very restrictive security measures in place.

Misdemeanant – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for not more than one year.

Murder – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of fifty-five years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Operational Capacity – The total bed capacity of the facility. The capacity of a facility is the number of beds authorized for safe and efficient operation of the facility.

Pre-Dispositional – An individual ordered by the Court to the Indiana Department of Correction for evaluation prior to sentencing.

Release – The means by which an offender leaves the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of an escape, this does not include a temporary absence.

Safekeeper – An individual whom the Court has determined to be in imminent danger of serious bodily injury or death, or who represents a substantial threat to the safety of others, and whom the Court has ordered to the Indiana Department of Correction for custody and security control.

Secure Confinement Units – Denotes maximum control with the most restrictive security measures in place.

Vacancy – The number of beds available for assignment.







LEGEND: Includes/Excludes County Jail "Back-ups" and Contracted Beds *
















