**Executive Summary**  
**May 2008**

Tables 4

- The number of juvenile offenders being supervised on Parole has decreased dramatically over the past few months. Many juvenile offenders who are over the age of 18 and are no longer involved with programming have been discharged from Parole.

- The number of adult female offenders supervised on Parole has increased approximately 48% over the last year. On June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007, the number of adult females on parole was 871, and as of June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008, there were 1,288 adult female parolees.

- The Average Daily Population for juvenile male offenders decreased by 34 offenders from April to May, averaging 801 offenders. This marks the lowest average population since August 2006, when the monthly average was 787.

## **Indiana Department of Correction Population Summary**

- There were 25,076 adult male offenders (including 1,795 county jail “back-ups” and 147 in contracted beds) on May 31, 2008. This population is 3% above the operational bed capacity.
  
- There were 2,354 adult female offenders (including 159 county jail “back-ups” and 67 in contracted beds) on May 31, 2008. This population is 1% above the operational bed capacity.
  
- There were 786 juvenile male offenders in the Department’s facilities on May 31, 2008. This population is 19% below the operational bed capacity.
  
- There were 146 juvenile female offenders in the Department’s facilities on May 31, 2008. This population is 27% below the operational bed capacity.
  
- There were 9,642 adult males on parole in Indiana (8,889 Indiana parolees and 753 other jurisdiction parolees) on May 31, 2008.
  
- There were 1,347 adult females on parole in Indiana (1,245 Indiana parolees and 102 other jurisdiction parolees) on May 31, 2008.
  
- There were 229 juvenile males on parole in Indiana (211 Indiana parolees and 18 other jurisdiction parolees) on May 31, 2008.
  
- There were 41 juvenile females on parole in Indiana (39 Indiana parolees and 2 other jurisdiction parolees) on May 31, 2008.

## Definitions

For the purpose of this report, the following definitions apply:

**Admission** – The means by which an offender enters the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of the return of an escapee, this does not include a return from a temporary absence.

**Average Daily Population** – The sum of the daily beginning counts for a month, divided by that month's number of daily beginning counts.

**Beginning Count** – The number of offenders physically present at the beginning of the day (ie, 0000:01 hours).

**Class A Felony** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of thirty years, with not more than twenty years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**Class B Felony** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of ten years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than four years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**Class C Felony** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of four years, with not more than four years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than two years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**Class D Felony** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of one and one-half years, with not more than one and one-half years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than one year subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**County Jail “Back-ups” (Jail Bed Count)** – Those offenders who have been committed to the Indiana Department of Correction, but are housed in a county jail until they can be transferred to a Department of Correction intake facility. The county receives \$35.00 per day, per offender, to house these offenders.

**Ending Count** – The number of offenders physically present at the end of the day (ie, 2400:00 hours).

**Felon** – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for more than one year.

**Level 1 Security Classification** – Minimum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 1 have the least restrictive security measures in place.

**Level 2 Security Classification** – Medium security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 2 have a moderate degree of security measures in place.

**Level 3 Security Classification** – Maximum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 3 have very restrictive security measures in place.

**Misdemeanant** – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for not more than one year.

**Murder** - An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of fifty-five years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**Operational Capacity** – The total bed capacity of the facility. The capacity of a facility is the number of beds authorized for safe and efficient operation of the facility.

**Pre-Dispositional** – An individual ordered by the Court to the Indiana Department of Correction for evaluation prior to sentencing.

**Release** – The means by which an offender leaves the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of an escape, this does not include a temporary absence.

**Safekeeper** – An individual whom the Court has determined to be in imminent danger of serious bodily injury or death, or who represents a substantial threat to the safety of others, and whom the Court has ordered to the Indiana Department of Correction for custody and security control.

**Secure Confinement Units** – Denotes maximum control with the most restrictive security measures in place.

**Vacancy** – The number of beds available for assignment.




Average Daily Adult Female Offender Populations






