Executive Summary

June 2007

Human Resources Report

- In June 2007 the number of Health Care contract/vendor personnel increased approximately 36% from 590 in May to 805 in June. While many adult facilities had a minimal increase in contract/vendor staff, Miami Correctional Facility increased 148% from 54 staff in May to 134 staff in June. This large increase is the result of Liberty hiring additional treatment staff for the care and supervision of sex offenders housed at Miami Correctional Facility.

Table 1

- In June 2007, New Castle Correctional Facility level 2 increased their count from 651 in May to 724 in June (11%). However, their General Population Vacancies also increased from 180 in May to 379 in June (110%). This increase in vacancies is due to New Castle Correctional Facility preparing to take on additional offenders as a result of the closing of the Medaryville Correctional Facility and the renovation project beginning at Westville Correctional Facility. These are not new offender beds, but transfers from other facilities.

- New commitments for males decreased approximately 20% from May to June 2007 and male parole violators with new commitments also decreased approximately 28% from May to June 2007. Overall admissions for males decreased 15% from May to June, while female admissions overall decreased 12% from May to June with incremental decreases witnessed across categories.

Indiana Department of Correction Population Summary

- There were 23,751 adult male offenders (including 1,276 county jail “back-ups” and 90 in contracted beds) on June 30, 2007. This population is 1% above the operational bed capacity.

- There were 2,125 adult female offenders (including 57 county jail “back-ups” and 62 in contracted beds) on June 30, 2007. This population is 5% below the operational bed capacity.

- There were 911 juvenile male offenders in the Department’s facilities on June 30, 2007. This population is 23% below the operational bed capacity.

- There were 183 juvenile female offenders in the Department’s facilities on June 30, 2007. This population is 42% below the operational bed capacity.

- There were 8,108 adult males on parole in Indiana (7,429 Indiana parolees and 679 other jurisdiction parolees) on June 30, 2007.

- There were 955 adult females on parole in Indiana (850 Indiana parolees and 105 other jurisdiction parolees) on June 30, 2007.

- There were 458 juvenile males on parole in Indiana (421 Indiana parolees and 37 other jurisdiction parolees) on June 30, 2007.

- There were 76 juvenile females on parole in Indiana (71 Indiana parolees and 5 other jurisdiction parolees) on June 30, 2007.

Definitions

For the purpose of this report, the following definitions apply:

Admission – The means by which an offender enters the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of the return of an escapee, this does not include a return from a temporary absence.

Average Daily Population – The sum of the daily beginning counts for a month, divided by that month's number of daily beginning counts.

Beginning Count – The number of offenders physically present at the beginning of the day (ie, 0000:01 hours).

Class A Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of thirty years, with not more than twenty years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Class B Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of ten years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than four years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Class C Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of four years, with not more than four years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than two years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Class D Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of one and one-half years, with not more than one and one-half years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than one year subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

County Jail “Back-ups” (Jail Bed Count) – Those offenders who have been committed to the Indiana Department of Correction, but are housed in a county jail until they can be transferred to a Department of Correction intake facility. The county receives \$35.00 per day, per offender, to house these offenders.

Ending Count – The number of offenders physically present at the end of the day (ie, 2400:00 hours).

Felon – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for more than one year.

Level 1 Security Classification – Minimum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 1 have the least restrictive security measures in place.

Level 2 Security Classification – Medium security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 2 have a moderate degree of security measures in place.

Level 3 Security Classification – Maximum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 3 have very restrictive security measures in place.

Misdemeanant – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for not more than one year.

Murder - An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of fifty-five years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Operational Capacity – The total bed capacity of the facility. The capacity of a facility is the number of beds authorized for safe and efficient operation of the facility.

Pre-Dispositional – An individual ordered by the Court to the Indiana Department of Correction for evaluation prior to sentencing.

Release – The means by which an offender leaves the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of an escape, this does not include a temporary absence.

Safekeeper – An individual whom the Court has determined to be in imminent danger of serious bodily injury or death, or who represents a substantial threat to the safety of others, and whom the Court has ordered to the Indiana Department of Correction for custody and security control.

Secure Confinement Units – Denotes maximum control with the most restrictive security measures in place.

Vacancy – The number of beds available for assignment.







LEGEND: Includes/Excludes County Jail "Back-ups" and Contracted Beds *
















