

## Executive Summary

### July 2007

Table 1

- There was a significant decrease (63%) in the general population vacancies for the Level 2 facilities due to New Castle Correctional Facility opening a new unit and moving offenders into those vacancies. New Castle's Level 2 offender population also increased from 724 to 1,001 (38%) for the same reason.

Table 4

- The adult parole figures appear to drastically increase from June 2007 to July 2007. The male figure jumps from 7,799 in June to 8,206 in July, an apparent 5% increase. The female parole population also appears to increase from 892 in June to 1,004 in July, a 12.5% increase. The increase, however, is not necessarily due to a larger than normal number of offenders being released to parole, but because of a switch in the reporting mechanism. Parole implemented a new Offender Case Management System (OCMS) that is more accurately tracking parolees in the system. Prior to the new OCMS being fully functional there was a dual reporting requirement to two separate databases. Within that reporting process some of the parolee data was not entered into the system from which the count reports were being generated. Now that the issue has been resolved the parole numbers are accurate.

Table 5

- There was a 4% increase in the total admissions from June 2007 to July 2007 and a 7% increase in the total releases from June to July. Both admission and release increases were spread across the various categories; however the majority of the increases came from parole violators admitted with new commitments and offenders released to parole.

Table 7

- The Community Transition Program (CTP) numbers are demonstrating a sustained increase over previous years' totals. On average, there are 30 more offenders enrolled in CTP each month when compared to the average rate for 2006. July 2007 witnessed the largest monthly increase to date compared to July 2006. In 2006 there were 384 offenders enrolled in CTP in July and in 2007 there were 470, a 22% increase.

## **Indiana Department of Correction Population Summary**

- There were 23,659 adult male offenders (including 1,173 county jail “back-ups” and 87 in contracted beds) on July 31, 2007. This population is 1% above the operational bed capacity.
  
- There were 2,131 adult female offenders (including 49 county jail “back-ups” and 61 in contracted beds) on July 31, 2007. This population is 4% below the operational bed capacity.
  
- There were 866 juvenile male offenders in the Department’s facilities on July 31, 2007. This population is 26% below the operational bed capacity.
  
- There were 182 juvenile female offenders in the Department’s facilities on July 31, 2007. This population is 42% below the operational bed capacity.
  
- There were 8,614 adult males on parole in Indiana (7,823 Indiana parolees and 791 other jurisdiction parolees) on July 31, 2007.
  
- There were 1,063 adult females on parole in Indiana (951 Indiana parolees and 112 other jurisdiction parolees) on July 31, 2007.
  
- There were 477 juvenile males on parole in Indiana (442 Indiana parolees and 35 other jurisdiction parolees) on July 31, 2007.
  
- There were 76 juvenile females on parole in Indiana (71 Indiana parolees and 5 other jurisdiction parolees) on July 31, 2007.

## Definitions

For the purpose of this report, the following definitions apply:

**Admission** – The means by which an offender enters the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of the return of an escapee, this does not include a return from a temporary absence.

**Average Daily Population** – The sum of the daily beginning counts for a month, divided by that month's number of daily beginning counts.

**Beginning Count** – The number of offenders physically present at the beginning of the day (ie, 0000:01 hours).

**Class A Felony** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of thirty years, with not more than twenty years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**Class B Felony** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of ten years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than four years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**Class C Felony** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of four years, with not more than four years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than two years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**Class D Felony** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of one and one-half years, with not more than one and one-half years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than one year subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**County Jail "Back-ups" (Jail Bed Count)** – Those offenders who have been committed to the Indiana Department of Correction, but are housed in a county jail until they can be transferred to a Department of Correction intake facility. The county receives \$35.00 per day, per offender, to house these offenders.

**Ending Count** – The number of offenders physically present at the end of the day (ie, 2400:00 hours).

**Felon** – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for more than one year.

**Level 1 Security Classification** – Minimum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 1 have the least restrictive security measures in place.

**Level 2 Security Classification** – Medium security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 2 have a moderate degree of security measures in place.

**Level 3 Security Classification** – Maximum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 3 have very restrictive security measures in place.

**Misdemeanant** – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for not more than one year.

**Murder** - An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of fifty-five years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**Operational Capacity** – The total bed capacity of the facility. The capacity of a facility is the number of beds authorized for safe and efficient operation of the facility.

**Pre-Dispositional** – An individual ordered by the Court to the Indiana Department of Correction for evaluation prior to sentencing.

**Release** – The means by which an offender leaves the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of an escape, this does not include a temporary absence.

**Safekeeper** – An individual whom the Court has determined to be in imminent danger of serious bodily injury or death, or who represents a substantial threat to the safety of others, and whom the Court has ordered to the Indiana Department of Correction for custody and security control.

**Secure Confinement Units** – Denotes maximum control with the most restrictive security measures in place.

**Vacancy** – The number of beds available for assignment.

















July 2007






