

Executive Summary

August 2007

Table 1 & Table 2

- An additional category has been added to the adult male Level 2 population figures. We are now reporting the number of Arizona inmates that are housed at New Castle Correctional Facility. The additional 611 offenders that are being reported account for the 5.4% increase in the total adult male Level 2 population.

Table 5

- New commitments for adult males increased 14.4% from July 2007 (748) to August 2007 (856), which helped account for the almost 18% increase in the total adult male admissions for August. Conversely, there was a 6% decrease in the number of adult male offenders being released from July to August, with the majority of the decrease being demonstrated by the almost 19% reduction in the number of offenders being released to probation.

- The juvenile female commitment rate for 2007 is currently 14% higher than the commitment rate for the same time period in 2006; however it is almost identical to the 2005 rate. The juvenile male commitment rates for 2007 are also approximately 7.2% higher than the rate for the same time period in 2006 and 10.4% higher than the 2005 rate. For both of these populations it is projected that the number of committed juvenile offenders will be approximately 15% higher for 2007 than for 2006.

Indiana Department of Correction Population Summary

- There were 24,450 adult male offenders (including 1,243 county jail “back-ups” and 84 in contracted beds) on August 31, 2007. This population is 1% above the operational bed capacity.

- There were 2,150 adult female offenders (including 71 county jail “back-ups” and 63 in contracted beds) on August 31, 2007. This population is 3% below the operational bed capacity.

- There were 846 juvenile male offenders in the Department’s facilities on August 31, 2007. This population is 28% below the operational bed capacity.

- There were 172 juvenile female offenders in the Department’s facilities on August 31, 2007. This population is 45% below the operational bed capacity.

- There were 8,757 adult males on parole in Indiana (7,975 Indiana parolees and 782 other jurisdiction parolees) on August 31, 2007.

- There were 1,124 adult females on parole in Indiana (1,012 Indiana parolees and 112 other jurisdiction parolees) on August 31, 2007.

- There were 486 juvenile males on parole in Indiana (453 Indiana parolees and 33 other jurisdiction parolees) on August 31, 2007.

- There were 77 juvenile females on parole in Indiana (73 Indiana parolees and 4 other jurisdiction parolees) on August 31, 2007.

Definitions

For the purpose of this report, the following definitions apply:

Admission – The means by which an offender enters the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of the return of an escapee, this does not include a return from a temporary absence.

Average Daily Population – The sum of the daily beginning counts for a month, divided by that month's number of daily beginning counts.

Beginning Count – The number of offenders physically present at the beginning of the day (ie, 0000:01 hours).

Class A Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of thirty years, with not more than twenty years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Class B Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of ten years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than four years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Class C Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of four years, with not more than four years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than two years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Class D Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of one and one-half years, with not more than one and one-half years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than one year subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

County Jail "Back-ups" (Jail Bed Count) – Those offenders who have been committed to the Indiana Department of Correction, but are housed in a county jail until they can be transferred to a Department of Correction intake facility. The county receives \$35.00 per day, per offender, to house these offenders.

Ending Count – The number of offenders physically present at the end of the day (ie, 2400:00 hours).

Felon – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for more than one year.

Level 1 Security Classification – Minimum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 1 have the least restrictive security measures in place.

Level 2 Security Classification – Medium security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 2 have a moderate degree of security measures in place.

Level 3 Security Classification – Maximum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 3 have very restrictive security measures in place.

Misdemeanant – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for not more than one year.

Murder - An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of fifty-five years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Operational Capacity – The total bed capacity of the facility. The capacity of a facility is the number of beds authorized for safe and efficient operation of the facility.

Pre-Dispositional – An individual ordered by the Court to the Indiana Department of Correction for evaluation prior to sentencing.

Release – The means by which an offender leaves the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of an escape, this does not include a temporary absence.

Safekeeper – An individual whom the Court has determined to be in imminent danger of serious bodily injury or death, or who represents a substantial threat to the safety of others, and whom the Court has ordered to the Indiana Department of Correction for custody and security control.

Secure Confinement Units – Denotes maximum control with the most restrictive security measures in place.

Vacancy – The number of beds available for assignment.







LEGEND: Includes/Excludes County Jail "Back-ups" and Contracted Beds *











LEGEND: Includes/Excludes County Jail "Back-ups" and Contracted Beds



August 2007






