

## Executive Summary

### September 2007

#### Table 5

- Total admissions decreased from August to September 2007 from 1,684 to 1,352 for males and females combined; a percent change of 19.7%. There was a 17.4% decrease in the number of new male commitments and a 16% decrease in the number of male technical parole violators. Overall, these two large changes accounted for the majority of the total decrease in new admissions, with minimal decreases witnessed across all other categories.

#### Table 7

- We are continuing to see significant increases in 2007 Community Transition Program enrollments when compared to all previous years. The enrollment number dropped slightly from August to September, but is still 10% higher than the September enrollment for 2006.

#### Graphs B & E

- There is a steady incline in the adult male and female average daily populations. These are anticipated increases as more offenders are incarcerated over time than are released. Since the beginning of calendar year 2007 there has been an increase of 825 adult male offenders, which accounts for a 3.6% increase, and an increase of 124 adult female offenders for a 6% increase (numbers include county jail back-ups and contract beds).

#### Table 11

- New commitments for juvenile males are down from August of 2007. The September number represents a 15.5% decrease and the lowest recorded number for September over the last 6 years.

## **Indiana Department of Correction Population Summary**

- There were 24,486 adult male offenders (including 1,290 county jail “back-ups” and 91 in contracted beds) on September 30, 2007. This population is 1% above the operational bed capacity.
  
- There were 2,207 adult female offenders (including 68 county jail “back-ups” and 62 in contracted beds) on September 30, 2007. This population is 1% below the operational bed capacity.
  
- There were 846 juvenile male offenders in the Department’s facilities on September 30, 2007. This population is 28% below the operational bed capacity.
  
- There were 178 juvenile female offenders in the Department’s facilities on September 30, 2007. This population is 43% below the operational bed capacity.
  
- There were 9,089 adult males on parole in Indiana (8,308 Indiana parolees and 781 other jurisdiction parolees) on September 30, 2007.
  
- There were 1,169 adult females on parole in Indiana (1,057 Indiana parolees and 112 other jurisdiction parolees) on September 30, 2007.
  
- There were 486 juvenile males on parole in Indiana (453 Indiana parolees and 33 other jurisdiction parolees) on September 30, 2007.
  
- There were 84 juvenile females on parole in Indiana (80 Indiana parolees and 4 other jurisdiction parolees) on September 30, 2007.

## Definitions

For the purpose of this report, the following definitions apply:

**Admission** – The means by which an offender enters the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of the return of an escapee, this does not include a return from a temporary absence.

**Average Daily Population** – The sum of the daily beginning counts for a month, divided by that month's number of daily beginning counts.

**Beginning Count** – The number of offenders physically present at the beginning of the day (ie, 0000:01 hours).

**Class A Felony** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of thirty years, with not more than twenty years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**Class B Felony** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of ten years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than four years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**Class C Felony** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of four years, with not more than four years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than two years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**Class D Felony** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of one and one-half years, with not more than one and one-half years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than one year subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**County Jail “Back-ups” (Jail Bed Count)** – Those offenders who have been committed to the Indiana Department of Correction, but are housed in a county jail until they can be transferred to a Department of Correction intake facility. The county receives \$35.00 per day, per offender, to house these offenders.

**Ending Count** – The number of offenders physically present at the end of the day (ie, 2400:00 hours).

**Felon** – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for more than one year.

**Level 1 Security Classification** – Minimum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 1 have the least restrictive security measures in place.

**Level 2 Security Classification** – Medium security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 2 have a moderate degree of security measures in place.

**Level 3 Security Classification** – Maximum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 3 have very restrictive security measures in place.

**Misdemeanant** – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for not more than one year.

**Murder** - An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of fifty-five years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**Operational Capacity** – The total bed capacity of the facility. The capacity of a facility is the number of beds authorized for safe and efficient operation of the facility.

**Pre-Dispositional** – An individual ordered by the Court to the Indiana Department of Correction for evaluation prior to sentencing.

**Release** – The means by which an offender leaves the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of an escape, this does not include a temporary absence.

**Safekeeper** – An individual whom the Court has determined to be in imminent danger of serious bodily injury or death, or who represents a substantial threat to the safety of others, and whom the Court has ordered to the Indiana Department of Correction for custody and security control.

**Secure Confinement Units** – Denotes maximum control with the most restrictive security measures in place.

**Vacancy** – The number of beds available for assignment.

















September 2007






