Executive Summary
September 2008**

Table 2

- 96 beds have been added to the operational capacity at the Madison Correctional Facility. Previous capacity was 500 and there are now a total of 596 level 1 female beds available at the facility.

Table 3

- Since January 2007, the number of adult female offenders in DOC facilities (excludes county jail beds and contracted beds) has increased over 13%, from 1,974 to 2,235.

Table 4

- The total number of offenders being supervised on Parole decreased for the fourth consecutive month. The 11,524 offenders on Parole represent the lowest Parole population thus far in 2008.

Indiana Department of Correction Population Summary

- There were 25,350 adult male offenders (including 1,735 county jail “back-ups” and 117 in contracted beds) on September 30, 2008. This population is 2% below the operational bed capacity.

- There were 2,422 adult female offenders (including 119 county jail “back-ups” and 68 in contracted beds) on September 30, 2008. This population is 3% below the operational bed capacity.

- There were 795 juvenile male offenders in the Department’s facilities on September 30, 2008. This population is 18% below the operational bed capacity.

- There were 132 juvenile female offenders in the Department’s facilities on September 30, 2008. This population is 34% below the operational bed capacity.

- There were 9,536 adult males on parole in Indiana (8,855 Indiana parolees and 681 other jurisdiction parolees) on September 30, 2008.

- There were 1,287 adult females on parole in Indiana (1,193 Indiana parolees and 94 other jurisdiction parolees) on September 30, 2008.

- There were 261 juvenile males on parole in Indiana (244 Indiana parolees and 17 other jurisdiction parolees) on September 30, 2008.

- There were 41 juvenile females on parole in Indiana (39 Indiana parolees and 2 other jurisdiction parolees) on September 30, 2008.

Definitions

For the purpose of this report, the following definitions apply:

Admission – The means by which an offender enters the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of the return of an escapee, this does not include a return from a temporary absence.

Average Daily Population – The sum of the daily beginning counts for a month, divided by that month's number of daily beginning counts.

Beginning Count – The number of offenders physically present at the beginning of the day (ie, 0000:01 hours).

Class A Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of thirty years, with not more than twenty years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Class B Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of ten years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than four years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Class C Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of four years, with not more than four years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than two years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Class D Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of one and one-half years, with not more than one and one-half years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than one year subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

County Jail "Back-ups" (Jail Bed Count) – Those offenders who have been committed to the Indiana Department of Correction, but are housed in a county jail until they can be transferred to a Department of Correction intake facility. The county receives \$35.00 per day, per offender, to house these offenders.

Ending Count – The number of offenders physically present at the end of the day (ie, 2400:00 hours).

Felon – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for more than one year.

Level 1 Security Classification – Minimum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 1 have the least restrictive security measures in place.

Level 2 Security Classification – Medium security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 2 have a moderate degree of security measures in place.

Level 3 Security Classification – Maximum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 3 have very restrictive security measures in place.

Misdemeanant – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for not more than one year.

Murder - An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of fifty-five years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Operational Capacity – The total bed capacity of the facility. The capacity of a facility is the number of beds authorized for safe and efficient operation of the facility.

Pre-Dispositional – An individual ordered by the Court to the Indiana Department of Correction for evaluation prior to sentencing.

Release – The means by which an offender leaves the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of an escape, this does not include a temporary absence.

Safekeeper – An individual whom the Court has determined to be in imminent danger of serious bodily injury or death, or who represents a substantial threat to the safety of others, and whom the Court has ordered to the Indiana Department of Correction for custody and security control.

Secure Confinement Units – Denotes maximum control with the most restrictive security measures in place.

Vacancy – The number of beds available for assignment.






Average Daily Adult Female Offender Populations Calendar Year 2008




Average Daily Adult Male Offender Populations Calendar Year 2008


