

**Executive Summary**  
**December 2007**

Table 7

- The yearly average number of offenders participating in the Community Transition Program in 2007 was 436. This marks the highest yearly average population since the inception of the Community Transition Program.

Table 10

- Fifteen male offenders were admitted to the Department for charges of Murder in December 2007. This is the largest number of monthly admissions for Murder since October 2006, when there were 16 offenders admitted.

Table 14

- Only nine female juvenile offenders were admitted to the Department during December 2007. This marks the lowest number of female juvenile admissions since August 2006, when there were five admissions.

## **Indiana Department of Correction Population Summary**

- There were 24,681 adult male offenders (including 1,590 county jail “back-ups” and 85 in contracted beds) on December 31, 2007. This population is 2% above the operational bed capacity.
  
- There were 2,190 adult female offenders (including 73 county jail “back-ups” and 63 in contracted beds) on December 31, 2007. This population is 2% below the operational bed capacity.
  
- There were 834 juvenile male offenders in the Department’s facilities on December 31, 2007. This population is 29% below the operational bed capacity.
  
- There were 180 juvenile female offenders in the Department’s facilities on December 31, 2007. This population is 42% below the operational bed capacity.
  
- There were 9,505 adult males on parole in Indiana (8,737 Indiana parolees and 768 other jurisdiction parolees) on December 31, 2007.
  
- There were 1,289 adult females on parole in Indiana (1,181 Indiana parolees and 108 other jurisdiction parolees) on December 31, 2007.
  
- There were 466 juvenile males on parole in Indiana (430 Indiana parolees and 36 other jurisdiction parolees) on December 31, 2007.
  
- There were 85 juvenile females on parole in Indiana (80 Indiana parolees and 5 other jurisdiction parolees) on December 31, 2007.

## Definitions

For the purpose of this report, the following definitions apply:

**Admission** – The means by which an offender enters the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of the return of an escapee, this does not include a return from a temporary absence.

**Average Daily Population** – The sum of the daily beginning counts for a month, divided by that month's number of daily beginning counts.

**Beginning Count** – The number of offenders physically present at the beginning of the day (ie, 0000:01 hours).

**Class A Felony** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of thirty years, with not more than twenty years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**Class B Felony** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of ten years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than four years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**Class C Felony** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of four years, with not more than four years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than two years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**Class D Felony** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of one and one-half years, with not more than one and one-half years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than one year subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**County Jail "Back-ups" (Jail Bed Count)** – Those offenders who have been committed to the Indiana Department of Correction, but are housed in a county jail until they can be transferred to a Department of Correction intake facility. The county receives \$35.00 per day, per offender, to house these offenders.

**Ending Count** – The number of offenders physically present at the end of the day (ie, 2400:00 hours).

**Felon** – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for more than one year.

**Level 1 Security Classification** – Minimum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 1 have the least restrictive security measures in place.

**Level 2 Security Classification** – Medium security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 2 have a moderate degree of security measures in place.

**Level 3 Security Classification** – Maximum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 3 have very restrictive security measures in place.

**Misdemeanant** – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for not more than one year.

**Murder** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of fifty-five years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**Operational Capacity** – The total bed capacity of the facility. The capacity of a facility is the number of beds authorized for safe and efficient operation of the facility.

**Pre-Dispositional** – An individual ordered by the Court to the Indiana Department of Correction for evaluation prior to sentencing.

**Release** – The means by which an offender leaves the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of an escape, this does not include a temporary absence.

**Safekeeper** – An individual whom the Court has determined to be in imminent danger of serious bodily injury or death, or who represents a substantial threat to the safety of others, and whom the Court has ordered to the Indiana Department of Correction for custody and security control.

**Secure Confinement Units** – Denotes maximum control with the most restrictive security measures in place.

**Vacancy** – The number of beds available for assignment.

















December 2007






