

# Randolph County Community Corrections

---

## **Agency Description:**

- Northeastern Indiana, population of **26,581**
- Predominately white (**98.3%**), non-white (**1.7%**)
- Per capita income **\$25,611** with a below poverty rate of **12.2%**
- Education: high school diploma (**79.6%**), BA Degree or higher (**9.9%**)
- Unemployment rate of **6.8%**

**Randolph County Community Corrections** received **185** adults and **15** juveniles during the 2007-2008 fiscal years (this does not include the referrals already being supervised prior to July 1, 2007). A total of **13** offenders in these programs were discharged as unsuccessful, **168** successful completions giving a combined success rate of **92%**.

## **Community Corrections Components:**

- Home Detention/EM
- Community Transition Program (CTP)
- Juvenile Alternatives (Wraparound, Drug Free Randolph County)
- Work Release/Residential
- Community Service

## **Program Effectiveness for 2007-2008:**

- Serves males, females, juveniles, felon misdemeanors, and infractions
- Courts submitted **17** referrals for Job Searchers on the Work Release program and **15** Work Release offenders obtained employment during this reporting period.
- An average of **24** offenders per month received Home Detention/EM services with an **83%** success rate during this reporting period.
- **10** offenders were CTP eligible and **8** were accepted. **5** offenders secured employment while on the CTP program during this reporting period.
- A total of **6** offenders were successfully discharged and **0** offenders unsuccessfully completed resulting in a **100%** success rate for CTP during this reporting period.
- Juvenile Alternatives Programs served **37** juveniles in Wraparound with an **83%** success rate during this reporting period. Drug Free Randolph County served **19** youth and sent them to Indiana Teen Institute Summer Leadership Camp.
- Community Service served **77** adults and **12** juveniles with an **84%** success rate during this reporting period.

## **Other Noteworthy Accomplishments:**

- 2008 - Randolph County Community Corrections renovated to update security and privacy issues for staff and offenders.
- 2008 - Initiated Thinking For a Change program.
- 2008 - Drug Free Randolph County at Indiana Teen Institute Summer Leadership Camp.
- 2008 - SADD program instituted in Randolph County
