

St. Joseph County Community Corrections

Agency Description:

- Northern Indiana, population of **266,678**
- Predominately white (**84.0%**), non-white (**16.0%**)
- Per capita income **\$32,354** with a below poverty rate of **13.5%**
- Education: high school diploma (**82.4%**), BA Degree or higher (**23.6%**)
- Unemployment rate of **5.1%**

County Community Corrections received **1,171** adults and **667** juveniles during the 2007-2008 fiscal years (this does not include the referrals already being supervised prior to July 1, 2007). A total of **684** offenders in these programs were discharged as unsuccessful, **1,084** successful completions giving a combined success rate of **59%**.

Community Corrections Components:

- Day Reporting - Home Detention/EM - Work Release/Residential
- Community Transition Program (CTP) - Reception Diagnostic - Forensic Diversion
- Juvenile Alternatives (Juvenile Home Detention/EM) - Community Service

Program Effectiveness for 2007-2008:

- Serves males, females, juveniles, felon misdemeanors, and infractions
- Employment was secured for **0** offenders during this reporting period.
- **50** offenders per month received Day Reporting services with a **57%** success rate during this reporting period.
- **78** offenders per month received Home Detention/EM services with a **56%** success rate during this reporting period.
- **437** offenders were CTP eligible and **209** were accepted. **78** offenders secured employment while on the CTP program during this reporting period.
- A total of **46** offenders were successfully discharged and **41** offenders unsuccessfully completed resulting in a **58%** success rate for CTP during this reporting period.
- Community Service served **158** adults and **0** juveniles. **0** offenders participated in Community Service as a graduated sanction with a **78%** success rate during this reporting period.
- Work Release Program maintained 20 offenders per day each month. Work release had a **59%** successful discharge rate during this reporting period.
- Juvenile Alternatives Programs served 0 juveniles with a **0%** success rate during this reporting period.
- Forensic Diversion Program served **47** offenders. Forensic Diversion had a **76%** successful discharge rate during this period
- Reception Diagnostic served 515 offenders. Reception Diagnostic assessed **515** Adults and **0** Juveniles and had a **40%** successful assessment rate during this period.
