NOTICE OF HEARING regarding the proposed acquisition of control by McLaren Health Care Corporation, a Michigan nonprofit corporation which is qualified to do business in the State of Indiana as a foreign nonprofit corporation, of MDwise, Inc., an Indiana domiciled health maintenance organization, with its principal office in Indianapolis, Indiana, from Indiana University Health, Inc., an Indiana nonprofit corporation, and the Health and Hospital Corporation of Marion County, an Indiana municipal corporation.

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held at the time and place specified above regarding the proposed acquisition of control of MDwise, Inc., an Indiana domiciled health maintenance organization, with its principal office in Indianapolis, Indiana.

The hearing will be held pursuant to Ind. Code 27-1-23-2, and will be conducted as required by that statute, as supplemented by the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Ind. Code 4-21.5-1 et seq. The hearing and subsequent determination shall be subject to Ind. Code 27-1-23-2 and 4-21.5-3.

The Insurance Commissioner of the State of Indiana, or the Commissioner's duly appointed designee, will preside as the administrative law judge at the hearing.

A copy of the public portions of the Form A Statement and other related materials filed with the Commissioner by the acquiring party are available for review at the offices of the Indiana Department of Insurance for all parties, policyholders and persons whose interest may be affected by the proposed acquisition. Requests for review of such documents shall be made, in writing, to Roy Eft, Chief Financial Examiner of the Indiana Department of Insurance, 311 West Washington Street, Suite 300, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204. Information concerning the hearing schedule and procedures may also be obtained by telephoning Mr. Eft, at (317) 232-2390.

Any member of the public interested in the proposed acquisition of control may attend the hearing. Any policyholder of MDwise, Inc., or other person whose interests may be affected by the proposed acquisition of control shall have the right to appear and become party to the proceeding. Any such policyholder or person wishing to appear and become a party must submit to the Indiana Insurance Commissioner, at the above address of the Indiana Department of Insurance, and with a copy to Mr. Eft and all parties named in the Form A Statement, a petition for intervention in accordance with the requirements of Ind. Code 4-21.5-3-21, setting forth facts demonstrating the person's standing to become a party under Ind. Code 27-1-23-2(k). Any petition for intervention must be submitted to and received by the Indiana Insurance Commissioner and Mr. Eft, with copies sent via mail to all parties named in the record of proceeding, no later than November 15, 2017.

Each party shall have the right to present evidence, examine and cross-examine witnesses, and offer oral and written arguments and, in connection therewith, shall be entitled to conduct discovery proceedings in the same manner as provided in the Indiana Rules of Trial Procedure. Ind. Code 27-1-23-2(k). A party who fails to attend or participate in the hearing, or other later stage of this proceeding, may be held in default or have a proceeding dismissed under Indiana Code § 4-21.5-3-24.
