PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 et seq. and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to **Michelle D. Bryant** ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for licensure with the commissioner on April 2, 2012. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application, the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance, ("Commissioner"), being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that the materials submitted indicate that Applicant has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b).

2. Applicant was convicted on October 30, 2000 with a Class C Felony for Child Exploitation, a Class C Felony for Vicarious Sexual Conduct, and a Class D Felony for Sexual Misconduct with a Minor.

3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that:

[i]f the commissioner refuses to renew a license or denies an application for a license; the commissioner shall notify the applicant or licensee and advise the applicant or licensee, in a writing sent through regular first class mail, of the

reason for the denial of the applicant's application or the non renewal of the licensee's license. The applicant or licensee may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application or non renewal of the licensee's license is mailed, make written demand to the commissioner for a hearing before the commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the commissioner's action. The hearing shall be held not more than thirty (30) days after the applicant or licensee makes the written demand, and shall be conducted under IC 4-21.5 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Applicant's request for licensure is hereby **DENIED** pursuant to Indiana Code 27-1-15.6-12(b).

FURTHERMORE, consent to participate in the business of insurance under 18 U.S.C. 1033, Federal Violent Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994, is hereby **DENIED**.
