FINAL ORDER

The Commissioner hereby incorporates the Agreed Entry as if fully set forth herein, and approves and adopts in full the Agreed Entry as a resolution of this matter.


IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Commissioner:

1. The Department hereby accepts application number 318997 and issues an insurance producer’s license to Applicant.
2. The Department acknowledges Applicant established a payment plan with the Indiana

Department of Revenue and provided to the Department documentation establishing said payment plan.

3. Applicant will provide to the Department documentation of her down payment within ten (10) days from the start date of said payment plan.
4. Applicant will provide to the Department documentation of all required payments made in the first ninety (90) days of said payment plan within ninety (90) days from the start date of said payment plan. .
5. Failure to provide the documentation required in Paragraphs 4 and 5 within the specified time periods will result in the immediate revocation of Applicant's license.

AGREED ENTRY

This Agreed Entry is executed by Adam H. Berry, Attorney for and on behalf of the State of Indiana, Department of Insurance ("Department"), and Wanda E. Hiles ("Applicant"), an applicant for a resident producer's license, to resolve all matters in the above cause number. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner, Indiana Department of Insurance.

WHEREAS, on or around June 2, 2012, Applicant applied for a resident producer's license; and,

WHEREAS, on or about April 18, 2011, a tax warrant was issued in Hancock County for Applicant resulting from the failure to pay state income tax; and,

WHEREAS, failure to pay state income tax is a violation of IC § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(14); and,

WHEREAS, the Department and Applicant desire to resolve their differences and settle the issues without a hearing;

IT IS THEREFORE NOW AGREED by and between the parties as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and Applicant in this administrative action.
2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the parties.
3. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing.
4. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
5. A resident producer's license shall be immediately granted to Applicant.
6. Applicant must establish a payment plan with the Indiana Department of Revenue and show payment in accordance with such payment plan within sixty (60) days of the Commissioner's Final Order adopting this Agreed Entry.
7. Should Applicant fail to provide the documentation required in Paragraph 6 within sixty (60) days, Applicant agrees to the immediate revocation of said license.
8. Applicant has carefully read this agreement and fully understands and accepts its terms.
9. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
