**FINAL ORDER**


The Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”) and LaShawna Purifie (“Purifie”), an applicant for an Indiana Non-Resident Producer License, signed an Agreed Entry which purports to resolve all issues involved in the action by the Department regarding Respondent’s license, and which has been submitted to the Commissioner of Insurance (the “Commissioner”) for approval.

The Commissioner, after reviewing the Agreed Entry, finds it has been entered into fairly and without fraud, duress or undue influence, and is fair and equitable between the parties. The Commissioner hereby incorporates the Agreed Entry as if fully set forth as attached as Exhibit A herein, and approves and adopts in full the Agreed Entry as a resolution of this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commissioner of Insurance:

1. Purifie failed to disclose a felony conviction on her application for licensure, in violation of Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1). The felony conviction has since been reduced to a misdemeanor.
3. Purifie will pay an Administrative Fine in the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00). The fine is to be paid within 30 days of the Final Order.
4. The Department agrees to accept Purifie's compliance with the terms of this agreement as full resolution of the issue.

**AGREED ENTRY**

This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”), by counsel, and LaShawna Purifie (“Purifie”), an Indiana non-resident insurance producer. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of the Commissioner of the Department.

WHEREAS, Purifie is a resident of Arizona;

WHEREAS, Purifie is a licensed insurance producer, holding license number 813194;

WHEREAS, on or about April 10, 2012, Purifie submitted an application for an Indiana Non-Resident Insurance Producer License;

WHEREAS, Purifie failed to disclose a criminal conviction on her license application in accordance with Indiana Code;


WHEREAS, the Department and Purifie desire to settle the issues without a hearing; and  
IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the parties as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter of and the parties to this Agreed Entry.
2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the parties.
3. Purifie voluntarily and freely waives her right to a public hearing.
4. Purifie voluntarily and freely waives her right to petition for judicial review of this agreement and the Commissioner's Final Order.
5. Purifie failed to disclose a felony conviction on her application for licensure, in violation of Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1). The felony conviction has since been reduced to a misdemeanor.
6. Purifie agrees to pay an Administrative Fine in the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00). The fine is to be paid within 30 days of the Commissioner's Final Order.
7. The Department agrees to accept Purifie's compliance with the terms of this agreement as full resolution of the issue.
8. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
9. Purifie has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.


