PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-5 and Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to **Ideneicka Verse** (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Department (“Commissioner”), on July 9, 2012. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that the materials submitted indicate that Applicant has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b), specifically, on September 20, 2007, Applicant was convicted of a Felony for making false statements on a loan application to the United States Department of Agriculture Farm Services Agency (“AFSA”). Based on the false information provided in the AFSA application, Applicant fraudulently received a one hundred twenty-four thousand, three hundred dollar (\$124,300.00) loan from the AFSA.


2. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d), if the Commissioner refuses to renew a license or denies an application for a license, the Commissioner must notify the applicant in writing of the reason for the denial of the applicant's application.

3. Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action. The hearing shall be held not more than thirty (30) days after Applicant makes the written demand, and shall be conducted under Ind. Code 4-21.5.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby **DENIED** pursuant to Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b).

FURTHERMORE, consent to participate in the business of insurance under 18 U.S.C. 1033, Federal Violent Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994, is hereby **DENIED**.
