

licensee's license. The applicant or licensee may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application or non renewal of the licensee's license is mailed, make written demand to the commissioner for a hearing before the commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the commissioner's action. The hearing shall be held not more than thirty (30) days after the applicant or licensee makes the written demand, and shall be conducted under Ind. Code § 4-21.5 and Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Applicant's request for licensure is hereby **DENIED** pursuant to Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b).

FURTHERMORE, consent to participate in the business of insurance under 18 U.S.C. 1033, Federal Violent Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994, is hereby **DENIED**.
