**FINAL ORDER**

The Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”) and Shelly A. Thompson (“Thompson”), an applicant for an Indiana Resident Producer License, signed an Agreed Entry which purports to resolve all issues involved in the action by the Department regarding Respondent’s license application, and which has been submitted to the Commissioner of Insurance (the “Commissioner”) for approval.

The Commissioner, after reviewing the Agreed Entry, finds it has been entered into fairly and without fraud, duress or undue influence, and is fair and equitable between the parties. The Commissioner hereby incorporates the Agreed Entry as if fully set forth as attached as Exhibit A herein, and approves and adopts in full the Agreed Entry as a resolution of this matter.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commissioner of Insurance:

1. The Department will issue Thompson a resident insurance producer license on a probationary basis. The terms of the probation are as follows: Thompson will be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year. If Thompson violates any

Indiana insurance law, the Department will file a Statement of Charges against her, and the matter will be set for an administrative hearing. Thompson will be subject to a ten thousand dollar (\$10,000.00) civil penalty for each offense, as well as the permanent revocation of her resident producer license.

2. Upon the Commissioner's signature of the Final Order, the Department will process Thompson's application in the normal manner.
3. The Department agrees to accept Thompson's compliance with the terms of this agreement as full resolution of the issues regarding her application.

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**AGREED ENTRY**

This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel Adam H. Berry, and Respondent Shelly A. Thompson ("Thompson"), an applicant for a resident insurance producer license. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of the Department's Commissioner, Stephen W. Robertson.

WHEREAS, Thompson is a resident of Indiana;

WHEREAS, on or about August 6, 2012, Thompson submitted an application for an Indiana resident insurance producer license; and

WHEREAS, the Department and Thompson desire to resolve their differences and settle the issues without a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the parties as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter of and the parties to this Agreed Entry.
2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the parties.

3. Thompson voluntarily and freely waives her right to a public hearing.
4. Thompson voluntarily and freely waives her right to petition for judicial review of this Agreed Entry and the Commissioner's Final Order.
5. The Department will issue Thompson a resident insurance producer license on a probationary basis. The terms of the probation are as follows: Thompson will be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year. If Thompson violates any Indiana insurance law, the Department will file a Statement of Charges against her, and the matter will be set for an administrative hearing. Thompson will be subject to a ten thousand dollar (\$10,000.00) civil penalty for each offense, as well as the permanent revocation of her resident producer license.
6. Upon the Commissioner's signature of the Final Order, the Department will process Thompson's application in the normal manner.
7. The Department agrees to accept Thompson's compliance with the terms of this agreement as full resolution of the issues regarding her application.
8. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
9. Thompson has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.
