PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-5 and Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to **Julie Ann Redmon** (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Department (“Commissioner”), on or about October 25, 2012. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that the materials submitted indicate that Applicant has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b), specifically, on December 22, 2010, Applicant’s nursing license was placed on indefinite suspension for allegations of missing patient medications by the Indiana State Board of Nursing.

2. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d), if the Commissioner refuses to renew a license or denies an application for a license, the Commissioner must notify the applicant in writing of the reason for the denial of the applicant's application.

3. Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action. The hearing shall be held not more than thirty (30) days after Applicant makes the written demand, and shall be conducted under Ind. Code 4-21.5.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby **DENIED** pursuant to Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b).
