

MOTION TO REVOKE BAIL AGENT LICENSE

Comes now the Bail Bond Division (“Division”), by its counsel, Robert L. Hummel, and shows the Court as follows:


1. That on February 13, 2013, Respondent was found guilty of three (3) counts of False Informing, Class B Misdemeanors, in Morgan County (Indiana) Superior Court #2. *See Exhibit “A” attached hereto.*
2. That on February 15, 2013, the Division obtained a certified copy of the court’s order.
3. That Ind. Code §27-10-3-8(d) states: “The Commissioner shall revoke the license of any person who is convicted of a disqualifying offense immediately upon conviction. The pending of sentencing or the pending of an appeal of a conviction of a disqualifying offense does not stay the revocation of a license under this subsection.”

4. That Ind. Code §27-10-3-8(d) further states: "A person convicted of a misdemeanor disqualifying offense is not eligible to reapply for a license until five (5) years from the date of conviction or release from imprisonment, parole, or probation, whichever is later."

5. That since an element of the crime of False Informing is dishonesty, Respondent was convicted of disqualifying misdemeanor offenses under Ind. Code §27-10-1-6.

WHEREFORE, the Division, by its counsel, Robert L. Hummel, respectfully requests that the Commissioner issue an order revoking Respondent's bail agent license per the terms of Ind. Code §27-10-3-8(d).
