**FINAL ORDER**



1. Respondent will pay an administrative fine of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) within thirty (30) days of the Commissioner's Final Order.
2. Upon receipt of the Administrative Fine payment, Respondent's Producer License Application 368099 will be accepted and approved.

3. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with the terms of this agreement as full resolution of the issues regarding Respondent's producer license application.

6. Should this Agreed Entry not be approved by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
7. Respondent has carefully read this agreement and fully understands and accepts its terms.


