PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 et seq. and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Jennifer Kinzie (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for licensure with the Commissioner on October 10, 2013. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application, the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance, (“Commissioner”), being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b). Specifically, Applicant has previous convictions for Theft, a Class D Felony in September 2012 in Jackson Circuit Court.

2. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that:
[i]f the commissioner refuses to renew a license or denies an application for a license; the commissioner shall notify the applicant or licensee and advise the applicant or licensee, in a writing sent through regular first class mail, of the reason for the denial of the applicant’s application or the non renewal of the licensee’s license. The applicant or licensee may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant’s application or non renewal of the licensee’s license is mailed, make written demand to the commissioner for a hearing before the commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the commissioner’s action. The hearing shall be held not more than thirty (30) days


after the applicant or licensee makes the written demand, and shall be conducted under Indiana Code §4-21.5.

3. If you choose to make a written demand for a hearing, please submit a completed application for written consent under 18 U.S.C. §1033 Federal Violent Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994 (available at www.in.gov/idoi) at the hearing, or prior to the hearing, to the attention of Investigator Kim Green.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b).

FURTHERMORE, consent to participate in the business of insurance under 18 U.S.C. §1033, Federal Violent Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994, is hereby DENIED.
