This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel, Michael F. Mullen, and Steve L. Deleon ("Applicant"), to resolve all issues in the above-captioned cause number. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance.

WHEREAS, Applicant submitted an application for a Non-Resident Producer's license on October 3, 2013; and

WHEREAS, on said license application, Applicant failed to disclose a 2007 administrative action taken against his resident license by the Texas Department of Insurance; and

WHEREAS, on said license application, Applicant failed to disclose a 2005 administrative action taken against his nonresident license by the Florida Department of Financial Services; and

WHEREAS, the Department alleges that Applicant's conduct constitutes a violation of Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(1); and


WHEREAS, the Department and Applicant (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the parties as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this Agreed Entry.
2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
3. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on this matter.
4. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this agreement and the Commissioner's Final Order.
5. Applicant shall pay an administrative fine in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars and 00/100 (\$500.00) within sixty (60) days of the Commissioner's Final Order adopting this Agreed Entry.
6. Provided no other issues arise, once said administrative fine is paid, Applicant's application for licensure shall be granted.
7. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.

8. Applicant has carefully read this agreement and fully understands and accepts its terms.


