PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Ind. Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.*, and Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to **Carolyn Van Zant** ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for licensure with the Department on or around May 22, 2014. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application, the Commissioner of the Department ("Commissioner"), being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b); specifically, Applicant's Florida law license currently is and has been suspended since March 2007.

2. Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b) provides, in part, as follows:

The commissioner may reprimand, levy a civil penalty, place an insurance producer on probation, suspend an insurance producer's license, revoke an insurance producer's license for a period of years, permanently revoke an

insurance producer's license, or refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license, or take any combination of these actions, for any of the following causes:

(8) Using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, unworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.

3. Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after this notice is mailed, make a written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action. The hearing will be held not more than thirty (30) days after Applicant's demand and will be conducted under Ind. Code 4-21.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby denied pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b).
