ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NOTICE OF NONRENEWAL OF LICENSE

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Lawrence M. Blusewicz, (“Respondent”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Respondent, a resident of New Jersey, is a licensed insurance producer, holding license number 754812 since May of 2011 (“Respondent’s license”).
2. Respondent’s license will expire on August 31, 2015.
3. On or about August 1, 2014 the Enforcement Division was notified that Respondent’s nonresident license was revoked by the Wyoming Insurance Department on July 11, 2014, for failure to disclose criminal history on his license application.
4. Additionally, the Department has learned that Respondent’s license has been revoked in Ohio (August, 2013), Kentucky (February, 2014) and Virginia (May, 2014).
5. Respondent did not disclose these administrative actions to the Department.
6. Respondent also failed to disclose his Florida 2007 Felony for Possession of Cocaine on his May 2011 application for licensure.

7. Pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license if the producer has provided incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.

8. Pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9), the Commissioner is may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license if the producer has had a producer's license, or its equivalent, revoked in any other jurisdiction.

9. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) requires the Commissioner to notify a licensee of the reason for the nonrenewal of his license. This Order serves as that notice.

10. The Commissioner further notifies Respondent that, pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d), Respondent may, within sixty three (63) days of receiving this Order, make a written demand upon the Commissioner for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this action. Such a hearing shall be held within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of Respondent's written demand.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, the Commissioner of Insurance hereby notifies Respondent that **his license shall not be renewed.**
