**PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**  
**AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL**

The Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Ind. Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.*, and Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to **Laura Booth** (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for licensure with the Department on or around September 20, 2014. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application, the Commissioner of the Department (“Commissioner”), being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b), and therefore the license is denied.

2. Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b) provides a list of causes by which the Commissioner may refuse to issue a license. Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) states that providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information is one such basis. Additionally, Ind.

Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) states that having an insurance producer's license revoked in another state is also grounds for denial.

3. Applicant stated on the application that she had not be subject to an administrative hearing or had her license revoked in another state. Applicant had her license revoked in the state of Virginia in 2002. Therefore, she both provided incomplete and materially untrue information on her application and has had a license revoked in another state.

4. Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after this notice is mailed, make a written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action. The hearing will be held not more than thirty (30) days after Applicant's demand and will be conducted under Ind. Code 4-21.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby denied pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b).
