ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NOTICE OF NONRENEWAL OF LICENSE

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.*, and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to John Freeman, (“Respondent”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Respondent, a resident of Colorado, is a licensed insurance producer, holding license number 836291 since August of 2012 (“Respondent’s license”).
2. Respondent’s license will expire on April 30, 2015.
3. On or about January 07, 2015 the Enforcement Division was notified that Respondent’s nonresident license was revoked by the South Dakota Division of Insurance on December 05, 2014 for his failure to report other states actions.
4. The Department has learned that Respondent’s license was denied in Florida (April, 2014) and Virginia (May, 2014).

5. Additionally, Respondent's license has been revoked in Virginia (October, 2013), Maryland (June, 2014), California (July, 2014), Kansas (November, 2014), and Wyoming (April, 2015).

6. Respondent did not disclose these administrative actions to the Department.

7. Respondent also failed to disclose the deferred adjudication of his Texas 1999 Felony for Possession of Cocaine, and his Texas 2005 Misdemeanor conviction for Possession of Marijuana on his August 27, 2012 application for licensure.

8. Pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-17(a), a producer shall report to the commissioner any administrative action taken against the producer in another jurisdiction or by another governmental agency in Indiana not more than thirty (30) days after the final disposition of the matter.

9. Pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license if the producer has provided incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.

10. Pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9), the Commissioner is may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license if the producer has had a producer's license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any other jurisdiction.


11. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) requires the Commissioner to notify a licensee of the reason for the nonrenewal of his license. This Order serves as that notice.

12. The Commissioner further notifies Respondent that, pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d), Respondent may, within sixty three (63) days of receiving this Order, make a written demand upon the Commissioner for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this

action. Such a hearing shall be held within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of Respondent's written demand.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, the Commissioner of Insurance hereby notifies Respondent that **his license shall not be renewed.**
