

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commissioner as follows:

1. Respondent’s Indiana Resident Producer License, number 685197, is hereby permanently revoked due to allegations of bogus business and forgery.

2. The Department agrees to accept this agreement as full resolution of this matter.

**AGREED ENTRY**

This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel, Brigitte R. Collier, and Dorothy Lajoie ("Respondent"), to resolve all issues in the above-captioned cause number. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance.

WHEREAS, Respondent is a licensed Resident Insurance Producer, holding license number 685197; and

WHEREAS, on or about March 03, 2015, Respondent was terminated from Aflac due to allegations of bogus business and forgery;

WHEREAS, the Respondent's conduct is a violation of Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8), which states that an insurance producer shall not use fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrate incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere;

WHEREAS, the Respondent's conduct is a violation of Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(10), which states that an insurance producer shall not forge another's name to an application for insurance or to any document related to an insurance transaction;

WHEREAS, the Department and Respondent (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the parties as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this Agreed Entry.
2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
3. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on the issues in this matter.
4. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
5. Respondent agrees to the Permanent Revocation of her Resident Insurance Producer's License.
6. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with this agreement as full satisfaction of this matter.
7. Respondent has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.
8. Respondent has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to duress, threat or undue influence.

9. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
10. Respondent is aware that failure to comply with any of the terms of this agreement will result in the matter being set for a hearing.
