**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**  
**NOTICE OF NONRENEWAL OF LICENSE**

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.*, and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Ellery Moreland, (“Respondent”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Respondent, a nonresident of Indiana, is a licensed insurance producer, holding license number 907887 since September of 2013 (“Respondent’s license”).
2. Respondent’s license expires on November 30, 2015.
3. On or about June 10, 2015, the Enforcement Division was notified that Respondent’s producer’s license with the North Dakota Insurance Department (“North Dakota”) was revoked on February April 22, 2015.
4. Respondent’s application for licensure was denied by North Dakota on September 01, 2015.
5. Respondent’ license renewal was denied by the Missouri Department of Insurance on September 04, 2015, and his application for licensure was denied on October 06, 2015.

6. Respondent failed to timely disclose all four (4) administrative actions to the Department.

7. On August 07, 1992 in Florida, Respondent was subject to the withheld adjudication of a misdemeanor charge for repeated telephone calls, which he failed to disclose on his application for licensure.

8. On June 18, 1996 in Florida, Respondent was convicted of misdemeanor resisting arrest without violence, which he failed to disclose on his application for licensure.

9. On June 25, 1997 in Florida, Respondent was subject to the withheld adjudication of two (2) counts of misdemeanor battery, which he failed to disclose on his application for licensure.

10. On March 16, 1998 in Florida, Respondent was convicted of misdemeanor soliciting another to commit prostitution, which he failed to disclose on his application for licensure.

11. On November 06, 2003 in Florida, Respondent as subject to the withheld adjudication of a misdemeanor charge for trespass in an unoccupied structure or conveyance, which he failed to disclose on his application for licensure.

12. Pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) the commissioner may refuse to renew a producer's license for having an insurance producer's license or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state, province, district or territory.

13. Pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-17(a), a producer shall report to the commissioner any administrative action taken against the producer in another jurisdiction or by another governmental agency in Indiana not more than thirty (30) days after the final disposition of the matter.

14. Pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) the commissioner may refuse to renew a producer's license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.

15. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) requires the Commissioner to notify a licensee of the reason for the nonrenewal of his license. This Order serves as that notice.

16. The Commissioner further notifies Respondent that, pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d), Respondent may, within sixty three (63) days of receiving this Order, make a written demand upon the Commissioner for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this action. Such a hearing shall be held within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of Respondent's written demand.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, the Commissioner of Insurance hereby notifies Respondent that **their license shall not be renewed.**
