FINAL ORDER


The Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”), by counsel Brigitte R. Collier, and Doron Sterling (“Respondent”), a licensed nonresident insurance producer, signed an Agreed Entry which purports to resolve all issues involved in the above-captioned cause number, and which has been submitted to the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (the “Commissioner”) for approval.

The Commissioner, after reviewing the Agreed Entry, finds it has been entered into fairly and without fraud, duress or undue influence, and is fair and equitable between the parties. The Commissioner hereby incorporates the Agreed Entry, as if fully set forth herein, and approves and adopts in full the Agreed Entry as a resolution of this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commissioner of Insurance:

1. Respondent shall pay an administrative fine of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) within ninety (90) days after the Commissioner signs the Final Order, for his failure to timely report a 2014 license denial by the Florida Department of Financial Services, and his failure to disclose the 2008 withheld adjudication of a Florida felony charge for grand larceny on his application for licensure.
2. The Department agrees to accept this agreement as full resolution of this matter.

AGREED ENTRY

This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel, Brigitte R. Collier, and Doron Sterling ("Respondent"), to resolve all issues in the above-captioned cause number. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance.

WHEREAS, Respondent is a licensed Nonresident Insurance Producer, holding license number 671969;

WHEREAS, on October 15, 2014, Respondent was subject to license denial by the Florida Department of Financial Services, which was not timely reported to the Department;

WHEREAS, on July 17, 2008, Respondent was subject to the withheld adjudication of a Florida felony charge for grand larceny which was subsequently dismissed on November 1, 2009;

WHEREAS, Respondent's conduct is in violation of Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-17(a) which states that a producer shall report to the commissioner any administrative action taken

against the producer in another jurisdiction or by another governmental agency in Indiana not more than thirty (30) days after the final disposition of the matter.

WHEREAS, Respondent's conduct is in violation of Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) which states that a producer shall not provide incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application;

WHEREAS, the Department and Respondent (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the parties as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this Agreed Entry.
2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
3. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on the issues in this matter.
4. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
5. Respondent shall pay an administrative fine of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) to the Department within ninety (90) days after the Commissioner signs the Final Order adopting this Agreed Entry.
6. Should additional violations manifest, this fine shall be in addition to any administrative actions for the new violation.
7. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with this agreement as full satisfaction of this matter.
8. Respondent has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.

9. Respondent has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to duress, threat or undue influence.
10. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
11. Respondent is aware that failure to comply with any of the terms of this agreement will result in the matter being set for a hearing.
