PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Michael Dowling (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on January 21, 2016.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) provides that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, demonstrating incompetence, or untrustworthiness.

4. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) provides, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for having been convicted of a felony.
5. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) and §27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) due to having been convicted in Madison Superior Courts of the following: a August 11, 2001 conviction of Misdemeanor Domestic Battery and Invasion of Privacy, a November 2, 1997 conviction of Misdemeanor Public Intoxication, a May 21, 2006 conviction of Misdemeanor Operating While Intoxicated, a June 21, 2010 conviction of Felony Operating a Vehicle with an ACE of .15 or More.
6. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), due to multiple misdemeanor convictions and a felony conviction in the State of Indiana.
