ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NOTICE OF NONRENEWAL OF LICENSE

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.*, and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Ian James Norris, (“Respondent”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Respondent, a nonresident of Indiana, is a licensed insurance producer, holding license number 557692 since September of 2007 (“Respondent’s license”).
2. Respondent’s license expires on March 31, 2016.
3. On or about February 09, 2016 the Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Enforcement Division”) received notification from the National Insurance Producer Registry database that Respondent’s resident license in Florida was suspended on April 23, 2015.
4. The Enforcement Division discovered that in Florida on January 06, 2015, Respondent was indicted on five (5) counts of second-degree felony grand theft.

5. Additionally, it was discovered that Respondent had been subject to two (2) producer's license suspensions in Washington and Ohio, and a producer's license revocation in Louisiana.

6. Respondent did not report the four (4) administrative actions or his criminal proceedings to the Department.

7. Pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) the Commissioner may refuse to renew a producer's license for having an insurance producer's license or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state, province, district or territory.

8. Pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-17(a), a producer shall report to the commissioner any administrative action taken against the producer in another jurisdiction or by another governmental agency in Indiana not more than thirty (30) days after the final disposition of the matter.

9. Pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-17(b), not more than thirty (30) days after an initial pretrial hearing date, a producer shall report to the Commissioner any criminal prosecution of the producer initiated in any jurisdiction.

10. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) requires the Commissioner to notify a licensee of the reason for the nonrenewal of his license. This Order serves as that notice.

11. The Commissioner further notifies Respondent that, pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d), Respondent may, within sixty three (63) days of the mailing of this Order, make a written demand upon the Commissioner for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this action. Such a hearing shall be held within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of Respondent's written demand.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, the Commissioner of Insurance hereby notifies Respondent that **his license shall not be renewed** for having four (4) licenses suspended or revoked, and for his failure to report his criminal proceedings and administrative actions to the Department.
