**PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**  
**AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL**

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Tyler S. Riney ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for resident licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on March 07, 2016.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12 due to his failure to disclose the withheld adjudication of his April 24, 2013 charges for Dealing in

Marijuana, Maintaining a Common Nuisance, and two (2) counts of Possession of a Controlled Substance, all Class D Felonies. Additionally, Applicant failed to disclose his April 30, 2015 convictions for Dealing in Marijuana, Maintaining a Common Nuisance, and two (2) counts of Possession of a Controlled Substance, all Class A Misdemeanors.

5. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12 (b) due to his failure to disclose the withheld adjudication of four (4) felony charges and four (4) misdemeanor convictions in an application for licensure.
