**PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**  
**AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL**

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Janet McDaniel (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on May 23, 2016.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for using fraudulent, coercive, dishonest practices, demonstrating incompetence, or untrustworthiness in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.
4. Following a review of materials which were submitted in the Applicant’s application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully

met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) due to multiple convictions in Iowa including a conviction of Possession of a Controlled Substance in 2014, a conviction of Possession of a Controlled Substance in 2012, a conviction of Criminal Mischief 5<sup>th</sup> Degree in 2011, a conviction of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia in 2010, a conviction of Theft 5<sup>th</sup> Degree in 2009, a conviction of Possession of Controlled Substance in 2009, and a conviction of Restraint of an Animal in 1999.

5. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant or licensee may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(8), due to a conviction of Possession of a Controlled Substance in 2014, a conviction of Possession of a Controlled Substance in 2012, a conviction of Criminal Mischief 5<sup>th</sup> Degree in 2011, a conviction of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia in 2010, a conviction of Theft 5<sup>th</sup> Degree in 2009, a conviction of Possession of Controlled Substance in 2009, and a conviction of Restraint of an Animal in 1999.
