PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Chad A. Huddleston (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on August 15, 2016.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12 based on

Applicant's failure to disclose two administrative actions by the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"): 1) a January 6, 2011 Probation Order wherein Applicant's license was placed on probation for failure to pay child support pursuant to Indiana Code 27-1-15.6-29; and, 2) a February 7, 2011, Final Order issued by the Commissioner adopting an Agreed Entry between the Department and the Applicant wherein Applicant agreed to permanently surrender his producer license for failing to notify the Department of his change of address within thirty (30) days as required by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-7(h).

5. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12 (b).
