
FINAL ORDER

The Commissioner having been duly advised now adopts the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommended Order with the following modifications pursuant to 4-21.5-3-29.

1. Julie Liane Nicholson is the Petitioner for an Indiana producer license in this matter. All references to the Petitioner as Respondent are changed to Petitioner.
2. The Findings of Fact are amended to include specific reference to Ind. Code §§35-44-3-9(1) and 35-44-1-5 regarding Petitioner's felony convictions.
3. The Findings of Fact are amended to include Conestoga Title Company as the Petitioner's employer.
4. The Findings of Fact are amended to include the name of Petitioner's current supervisor, Jennifer N. Stanley.
5. The Findings of Fact are amended to note Ms. Stanley's felony convictions and pending matter with the Department of Insurance under Cause #3356-AG06-0411-052.
6. The Findings of Fact are amended to strike the citations to the "Enforcement Court File." The Enforcement Division's file was not introduced as evidence.

7. Petitioner's license may be terminated for failure to comply with this order on an *ex parte* emergency basis pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-4 or after hearing.
8. Representative Turner was a character witness for, and former employer of, Petitioner. As such, he is not in a position to review or approve probationary reports as they relate to Petitioner's performance at Conestoga Title Company.
9. Any supervision of Petitioner by Rep. Turner is not subject to this order, but the Department recognizes and appreciates the value and commitment of the Representative's offer to review the reports and would strongly encourage Petitioner to continue to avail herself of Representative Turner as a guide and mentor.
10. Petitioner's probation reports must be co-signed by two representatives of her employer, which may include the immediate supervisor so long as the supervisor maintains current licensure.
11. Petitioner must submit the signed reports to the Department within the time frame specified in the Recommended Order.
12. The Findings of Fact are amended to include that Petitioner properly applied for consent to engage in the business of insurance pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §1033.
13. Petitioner is hereby granted a license and also consent under 18 U.S.C. §1033.
14. The portion of the Recommended Order, stating that Petitioner's license will "terminate immediately," is stricken. If Petitioner is issued a license, she is entitled to a hearing if and when a revocation of that license is pursued.
15. All other portions of the Recommended Order, Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law not modified are hereby adopted.
