Dear Mr. Henschen:

Pursuant to IC 13-18-21 and 327 IAC 14 and Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. § 470f) and 36 C.F.R. Part 800, the Indiana State Historic Preservation Officer ("Indiana SHPO") is conducting an analysis of the materials dated and received by the Indiana SHPO on August 24, 2012, for the above indicated project in Terre Haute, Honey Creek Township, Vigo County, Indiana.

Based on our analysis, it has been determined that no historic structures will be altered, demolished, or removed by the proposed project.

In terms of archaeology, site 12Vi56 (a prehistoric mound) was recorded in 1949 within the proposed project area specifically at the proposed location of the secondary clarifiers. However, it is our understanding that the existing wastewater treatment plant was constructed around the 1960s, and all of the existing plant has been substantially disturbed by construction activities including the location of the archaeological site. No archaeological investigations appear necessary for this project provided that all ground disturbing activities remain within areas disturbed by previous construction.

If any archaeological artifacts, features, or human remains are uncovered during construction, state law (Indiana Code 14-21-1-27 & 29) requires that the discovery must be reported to the Department of Natural Resources within two (2) business days. In that event, please call (317) 232-1646. Be advised that adherence to Indiana Code 14-21-1-27 and 29 does not obviate the need to adhere to applicable federal statutes and regulations.
