Thank you for copying me on your letter of April 16, 2012 to Ms. Shively Klem of the Indiana Brownfields Program (IBP) regarding the planned remediation of the subject property. At this time, U.S. EPA believes that all of the available documentation regarding the federal involvement, description of the area including photographs, maps, drawings and remediation plans for the subject property has been reviewed. In addition, the IBP and Indiana State Historic Preservation Officer (Indiana SHPO) have taken all the necessary steps to identify any potential historic properties. Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. Section 800.11(d), U.S. EPA has determined that a finding of 'no historic properties affected' accurately reflects the status of the site.

The submittal for the site included information on the federal funding source, site background, historical status of site; sources of historical information and enclosures that included pictures, maps and detailed descriptions of the remediation work proposed for the site.
