


PROSECUTOR UPDATE

Since its inception in May of 2005, Indiana Prosecutors have charged over 37 people with Office of Inspector General (OIG) cases.

In addition to its role of investigating criminal activity, the OIG also creates and maintains a Code of Ethics for Executive Branch state employees. This new Code of Ethics was adopted in January of 2006. For the first time, all ethics rules applicable to the Executive Branch of Indiana Government were codified by the OIG into a uniform set of rules in 42 IAC 1-5. Previously, these ethics rules were scattered in various statutes and administrative rules.
