State Why Acceptance is in the Public Interest: The Champions of Diversity Annual Awards Dinner is the largest cross-sector diversity awards in the U.S. to recognize individuals, companies, and organizations that have exhibited a high level of commitment to diversity. The Indiana Civil Rights Commission (ICRC) enforces the Indiana civil rights laws and provides education and services to the public to ensure equal opportunity for all Hoosiers and visitors to the State of Indiana. ICRC serves as an important societal influence to eradicate illegal discrimination in Indiana and houses the State of Indiana's five cultural commissions. One of the five cultural commissions, the Indiana Commission for Women (ICW), serves under the umbrella of the Indiana Civil Rights Commission to provide education, resources, and initiatives for Indiana's minority, underrepresented, and ethnically diverse communities. This event will be an opportunity to network with other local organizations and agencies to discuss the overall mission of the agency (i.e. ICRC and ICW), and recognize Indiana's champions of diversity. Additionally, two out of the 20 recipients of the 2024 Champions of Diversity are recipients of the ICW's 2023 Torchbearer Awards. The Torchbearer Awards ceremony honors the many achievements of Hoosier women; and is a statute charged to the commission to "identify and recognize the contributions made by Indiana women to their community, state, and nation."
