

**Brief Description of Item Solicited, Accepted, or Received:** Transportation, lodging, subsistence and food for attending a highly pathogenic avian influenza meeting.



**Nature of Business Relationship with Agency:** The ISPA and the BOAH cooperate in implementing the National Poultry Improvement Plan (IC 15-17-10-15). ISPA member companies are subject to BOAH regulatory jurisdiction (IC 15-17).

**Why Acceptance is in the Public Interest:** This meeting is related to the national response to an outbreak of highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI). Preparing and responding to the HPAI outbreak is a top priority for BOAH. Dr. Kopp's participation is directly related to his duties at the BOAH to control animal diseases in the state.
