

ORDER 2006-3

AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
CONCERNING THE DISCIPLINARY ACTION AGAINST
THE OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE OF JACKIE HUMANSKI
05-OL-HH-01

Jackie M. Humanski, a level 2 occupational licensee employed by Horseshoe Casino as a Cage Cashier, failed to respond to the Commission staff's repeated requests for information and documentation that the Commission staff deemed necessary to ensure that the licensee met the licensing requirements set forth in the Gaming Act and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code. On or about September 20, 2005, Commission staff filed a complaint for disciplinary action against Ms. Humanski. The Complaint was submitted to an Administrative Law Judge. On December 12, 2005, prior to a hearing being set, Ms. Humanski was terminated from her employment with Horseshoe. As a result, the Commission staff moved that the Complaint be withdrawn. The Administrative Law Judge issued a Recommended Order Granting Complainant's Motion to Withdraw Complaint for Disciplinary Action.

After reviewing the foregoing and the attached Recommended Order Granting Complainant's Motion to Withdraw Complaint for Disciplinary Action, the Commission hereby:




