

**ORDER 2010-152**

**AN ORDER REGARDING THE REQUEST FOR HEARING ON THE  
VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION REMITTANCE OF JOHN DOE #10-36**

On June 17, 2010, in Order 2010-70, the Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) approved remittance of \$5,000.00 that the Ameristar Casino owed to John Doe #10-36 for the reason that John Doe #10-36 was a participant in the Voluntary Exclusion Program at the time he/she was owed those monies while in the gaming area of the Ameristar Casino in East Chicago, Indiana.

Subsequently, John Doe #10-36 filed with the Commission a request for a hearing on Order 2010-70. On or about August 31, 2010, Commission staff agreed to settle John Doe #10-36’s request in lieu of conducting a hearing.

**COMMISSION ACTION**


After reviewing the foregoing, and in accordance with 68 IAC 7-1-15, the Commission hereby:

**APPROVES**


