

ORDER 2010-34
AN ORDER DENYING VICTOR SPAULDING'S APPLICATION FOR OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE

The Commission has considered the following factors:

On August 5, 2009, Mr. Spaulding applied for a permanent license, and was granted a temporary license to work as a Painter at Hollywood Casino.

The Commission background check on Mr. Spaulding showed multiple criminal charges and/or arrests that he did not disclose on his application.

On September 23, 2009, a Commission Gaming Agent served Mr. Spaulding with a letter requesting full disclosure of all criminal history within thirty (30) days.

The Commission did not receive a response to this letter from Mr. Spaulding

IC 4-33-8-7 states that the Commission may refuse to issue an occupational license to an individual who does not disclose or states falsely any information required by the application or who the Commission for just cause considers to be unfit to hold an occupational license.

68 IAC 2-3-4(b)(2) states that any misrepresentation or omission made regarding an application may be grounds for denial of the application.

68 IAC 2-3-5(b)(9) states that an applicant must comply with all requests for information, documents, or other materials relating to the applicant and his or her application during the investigation conducted by the Commission.


IC 4-33-8-5(a)(2) states that an application for an occupational license must contain all information required by the Commission.

Mr. Spaulding did not disclose several criminal charges/arrests on his application that were later discovered by Commission investigators during the licensing investigation, and Mr. Spaulding did not provide Commission staff with documents and information related to those criminal charges/arrests when that information was requested by Commission staff.

Based on the foregoing, the Commission hereby DENIES the Occupational License application of Victor Spaulding.
