

RESOLUTION 2011-110

**AN RESOLUTION GRANTING JON BOR'S REQUEST
FOR A WAIVER OF 68 IAC 2-3-5(c)(6)**

On May 8, 2008, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") issued to Jon Bor a Level 2 occupational license to work as a Field Service Tech for Aristocrat Technologies, Inc., a licensed casino supplier. Mr. Bor timely submitted an application for renewal of his occupational license in which he disclosed that the Seminole Nation Gaming Commission denied his license renewal application in September 2010. Commission staff found Mr. Bor otherwise suitable for licensure.

Pursuant to 68 IAC 2-3-5(c)(6), an applicant "must never have had a gaming license suspended or revoked in any jurisdiction." In a letter dated April 19, 2011, Mr. Bor submitted a written request to the Commission for waiver of 68 IAC 2-3-5(c)(6), pursuant to 68 IAC 2-3-12.

Having considered the foregoing and based on the following additional factors:

1. nature and circumstances of the offense,
2. petitioner's employment record,
3. the fact the offense was an isolated incident, and
4. petitioner's disclosure of the offense on his renewal application;

the Commission finds that Mr. Bor is suitable for renewal of his license and hereby GRANTS his request for waiver of 68 IAC 2-3-5(c)(6).
