

ORDER 2011-168

**AN ORDER REGARDING THE REQUEST FOR HEARING RE: THE
VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION REMITTANCE OF JOHN DOE #11-65**

On June 2, 2011, in Order 2011-104, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") approved remittance of \$6,600.00 that the Blue Chip Casino owed to John Doe #11-65 for the reason that John Doe #11-65 was a participant in the Voluntary Exclusion Program at the time he was owed those monies while in the gaming area of the Blue Chip Casino in Michigan City, Indiana.

Subsequently, John Doe #11-65 filed with the Commission a request for a hearing on Order 2011-104. On June 28, 2011, Commission staff agreed to settle the appeal with John Doe #11-65.

COMMISSION ACTION


After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with 68 IAC 7-1-15, the Commission hereby:


